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This has reference to your online proposal No. IA/HR/IND2/227212/2021, dated 01st September, 2021 for environmental clearance to the above mentioned project.

2. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has examined the proposal for proposed 215 KLPD Grain based Ethanol plant along with 6.0 MW Co-generation Power Plant at Village Firozpur, Tehsil Raipur Rani, District Panchkula, Haryana by M/s MG Petrochem Private Limited.

3. All grain based fuel ethanol plants are listed at S.N. 5(ga) of Schedule of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 amendment vide S.O 2339 dated 16th June 2021 under category 'B-2' and appraised at Central Level by Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC). It was informed that no litigation is pending against the proposal.

4. The details of products and capacity are as under: -

5. Total land required for the project is 7.76 hectares (77600 m²). Industry will develop greenbelt in an area of 33% i.e. 2.56 ha (25600 m²) out of total area of the project.

6. The estimated project cost is Rs. 205 Crores. Total capital cost earmarked towards environmental pollution control measures is Rs. 24.0 Crores and the Recurring cost (operation and maintenance) will be about Rs. 1.5 Crores / annum. Total Employment will be 120 persons (Permanent 72 & temporary 48) during operation phase. Industry proposes to allocate Rs. 1.0 Crores of total project cost towards Social developmental activities.

7. There are No National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries, Biosphere Reserves, Tiger/ Elephant Reserves, Wildlife Corridors, lies within 10 km radius of the project site. PF like Rajpura PF (~4.5 km in NE direction), Gumti Sambhalwa RF (~7.5 km in East direction) & Kadana PF (~8.5 km in NNE direction), River/Nala i.e. Balrali Nadi (~1.0 km in SSE direction), Thathar ki Nadi (~3.5 km in North direction), Baliali Nala (~4.5 km in South direction), Dangri Nadi (~4.5 km in NW direction), Sangrel Nadi (~5.5 km in NE direction), Begna Nadi (~5.5 km in ESE direction), Ujjal ki Nadi (~7.5 km in SE direction) and Dudhgarh ki Nadi (~8.5 km in NW direction); Baliali Nala

(4.5 km in South direction), Dhandiyon ka Nala (~7.0 km in ENE direction) and Naura Nala (~7.0 km in ENE direction) are found within 10 km radius.

8. Total water requirement for the Grain based Ethanol Plant will be 3439 KLPD out of which 2372 KLPD will be recycled in plant operations. Hence, the fresh water requirement for the project will be 1097 KLPD (Ethanol Plant & Co-generation Power Plant and Utilities 1067 m³/day + Domestic: 30 m³/day) which will be sourced from groundwater. Effluent of 1212 m³/day will be treated through state of art CPU/Effluent Treatment Plant (Reverse Osmosis technology) of 1500 KLPD capacity. The plant will be based on Zero Liquid discharge system.

9. Power requirement for Ethanol plant will be 4.0 MW, which will be sourced from the 6.0 MW Co-generation Power Plant. Construction power / standby power connection shall be taken from Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited. Unit will be having D.G. Sets of 2 x 1500 KVA which will be used as standby during power failure. Adequate Stack height (8 m) will be provided as per CPCB norms. Boiler of 50 TPH capacity with ESP as Air Pollution Control Equipment will be installed. ESP with a stack height of 60 m for 50 TPH boiler will be installed for controlling the particulate emissions within the statutory limit of 50 mg/Nm³.

10. Details of Process emissions generation and its management:

CO₂ (164 TPD) generated during the fermentation process will be recovered by CO₂ Scrubbers and sold to authorized vendors.

11. Details of Solid waste/Hazardous waste generation and its management:

- Solid waste from the Grain based operations generally comprises of fibres and proteins in the form of DDGS (94 TPD), which will be ideally used as Cattle, poultry & fish feed ingredients.
- Used oil & grease (0.5 KL/Annum) generated from plant machinery/gear boxes as hazardous waste will be sold out to the CPCB authorized recyclers.

12. As per OM dated 16th June, 2021, PP has submitted self-certification in the form of affidavit declaring that the proposed capacity of 215 KLPD will be for manufacturing of fuel ethanol only.

13. During the appraisal EAC noted that proposed parking area of 10 % shall be increased to 15% of the total project area and PP obliged to it.

14. The proposal was considered by the EAC in its 40th meeting held during 14th- 16th September, 2021 in the Ministry, wherein the project proponent and their consultant M/s J.M. EnviroNet Pvt. Ltd presented the EMP report as per the PFR. The Committee found the EMP report complying with the PFR and recommended the project for grant of environmental clearance.

15. The EAC, constituted under the provision of the EIA Notification, 2006 and comprising of Experts Members/domain experts in various fields, have examined the proposal submitted by the Project Proponent in desired form along with EIA/EMP report prepared and submitted by the Consultant accredited by the QCI/ NABET on behalf of the Project Proponent. The EAC noted that the Project Proponent has given undertaking that the data and information given in the application and enclosures are true to the best of his knowledge and belief and no information has been suppressed in the EIA/EMP report. If any part of data/information submitted is found to be false/ misleading at any stage, the project will be rejected and Environmental Clearance given, if any, will be revoked at the risk and cost of the project proponent.

16. The Committee has also deliberated on the CER plan and found to be addressing the issues in the study area. The EAC has deliberated the proposal and has made due diligence in the process as notified under the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006, as amended from time to time and accordingly made the recommendations to the proposal. The Experts Members of the EAC have found the proposal in order and have **recommended** for grant of environmental clearance.

17. The environmental clearance granted to the project/activity is strictly under the provisions of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments. It does not tantamount/construe to approvals/consent/ permissions etc. required to be obtained or standards/conditions to be followed under any other Acts/ Rules/ Subordinate legislations, etc., as may be applicable to the project. The project proponent shall obtain necessary permission as mandated under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as applicable from time to time, from the State Pollution Control Board, prior to construction & operation of the project.

18. Based on the proposal submitted by the project proponent and recommendations of the EAC (Industry-2), Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change hereby **accords** environmental clearance for establishment of proposed 215 KLPD Grain based Ethanol plant along with 6.0 MW Co-generation Power Plant at Village Firozpur, Tehsil Raipur Rani, District Panchkula, Haryana by M/s MG Petrochem Private Limited, under the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006, and the amendments therein, subject to compliance of the terms and conditions as under: -

A. Specific Conditions:

(i) As per OM dated 16th June, 2021, project falls in category B2 and the proposed additional capacity of 215 KLPD shall be only for fuel ethanol manufacturing as per self-certification in form of an affidavit by the Project Proponent. Provided that subsequently if it is found that the ethanol, produced based on the EC granted as per this dispensation, is not being used completely for EBP Programme, or if ethanol is not being produced, or

if the said distillery is not fulfilling the requirements based on which the project has been appraised as category B2 project, the EC shall stand cancelled.

(ii) The company shall comply with all the environmental protection measures and safeguards proposed in the documents submitted to the Ministry. All the recommendations made in the EIA/EMP in respect of environmental management, and risk mitigation measures relating to the project shall be implemented.

(iii) The project proponent will treat and reuse the treated water within the factory and no waste or treated water shall be discharged outside the premises.

(iv) Total fresh water requirement shall be 1097 KLPD which will be met ground water. Extraction of ground water shall not be done without obtaining prior permission of CGWA/concerned authority. No ground water recharge shall be permitted within the premises.

(v) The spent wash shall be concentrated and dried to form DDGS to be used as cattle feed.

(vi) CO₂ generated from the process shall be bottled/made solid ice and utilized/sold to authorized vendors.

(vii) Occupational Health Centre for surveillance of the worker's health shall be set up. The health data shall be used in deploying the duties of the workers. All workers & employees shall be provided with required safety kits/mask for personal protection.

(viii) Training shall be imparted to all employees on safety and health aspects of chemicals handling. Safety and visual reality training shall be provided to employees.

(ix) The unit shall make the arrangement for protection of possible fire hazards during manufacturing process in material handling. Firefighting system shall be as per the norms.

(x) Process organic residue and spent carbon, if any, shall be sent to Cement other suitable industries for its incinerations. ETP sludge, process inorganic & evaporation salt shall be disposed of to the TSDF.

(xi) The company shall undertake waste minimization measures as below
(a) Metering and control of quantities of active ingredients to minimize waste; (b) Reuse of by-products from the process as raw materials or as raw material substitutes in other processes. (c) Use of automated filling to minimize spillage. (d) Use of Close Feed system into batch reactors. (e) Venting equipment through vapour recovery system. (f) Use of high pressure hoses for equipment clearing to reduce wastewater generation.

(xii) The green belt of 5 m width shall be developed in nearly 33% of the total project area, mainly along the plant periphery. Selection of plant species shall be as per the CPCB guidelines in consultation with the State Forest Department. Records of tree canopy shall be monitored through remote sensing map.

(xiii) As committed PP shall allocate Rs. 1.0 Crore for CER and shall be used for implementing energy conservation measures and skill development for women/girls in nearby villages.

(xiv) There shall be 15% space inside the plant premises earmarked for parking of vehicles for raw materials and finished products as per CPCB norms and no parking to be allowed outside on public places.

(xv) Storage of raw materials shall be either stored in silos or in covered areas to prevent dust pollution and other fugitive emissions.

(xvi) Continuous online (24x7) monitoring system for stack emissions shall be installed for measurement of flue gas discharge and the pollutants concentration, and the data to be transmitted to the CPCB and SPCB server. For online continuous monitoring of effluent, the unit shall install web camera with night vision capability and flow meters in the channel/drain carrying effluent within the premises.

(xvii) A separate Environmental Management Cell (having qualified person with Environmental Science/Environmental Engineering/specialization in the project area) equipped with full-fledged laboratory facilities shall be set up to carry out the Environmental Management and Monitoring functions.

B. General Conditions:

(i) No further expansion or modifications in the plant, other than mentioned in the EIA Notification, 2006 and its amendments, shall be carried out without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change/SEIAA, as applicable. In case of deviations or alterations in the project proposal from those submitted to this Ministry for clearance, a fresh reference shall be made to the Ministry/SEIAA, as applicable, to assess the adequacy of conditions imposed and to add additional environmental protection measures required, if any.

(ii) The energy source for lighting purpose shall be preferably LED based, or advanced having preference in energy conservation and environment betterment.

(iii) The overall noise levels in and around the plant area shall be kept well within the standards by providing noise control measures including acoustic hoods, silencers, enclosures etc. on all sources of noise generation. The ambient noise levels shall conform to the standards prescribed under the

Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 Rules, 1989 viz. 75 dBA (day time) and 70 dBA (night time).

(iv) The company shall undertake all relevant measures for improving the socio-economic conditions of the surrounding area. CER activities shall be undertaken by involving local villages and administration and shall be implemented. The company shall undertake eco-developmental measures including community welfare measures in the project area for the overall improvement of the environment.

(v) The company shall earmark sufficient funds towards capital cost and recurring cost per annum to implement the conditions stipulated by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change as well as the State Government along with the implementation schedule for all the conditions stipulated herein. The funds so earmarked for environment management/pollution control measures shall not be diverted for any other purpose.

(vi) A copy of the clearance letter shall be sent by the project proponent to concerned Panchayat, Zilla Parishad/Municipal Corporation, Urban local Body and the local NGO, if any, from whom suggestions/ representations, if any, were received while processing the proposal.

(vii) The project proponent shall also submit six monthly reports on the status of compliance of the stipulated Environmental Clearance conditions including results of monitored data (both in hard copies as well as by e-mail) to the respective Regional Office of MoEF&CC, the respective Zonal Office of CPCB and SPCB. A copy of Environmental Clearance and six monthly compliance status report shall be posted on the website of the company.

(viii) The environmental statement for each financial year ending 31st March in Form-V as is mandated shall be submitted to the concerned State Pollution Control Board as prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, as amended subsequently, shall also be put on the website of the company along with the status of compliance of environmental clearance conditions and shall also be sent to the respective Regional Offices of MoEF&CC by e-mail.

(ix) The project proponent shall inform the public that the project has been accorded environmental clearance by the Ministry and copies of the clearance letter are available with the SPCB/Committee and may also be seen at Website of the Ministry and at <https://parivesh.nic.in/>. This shall be advertised within seven days from the date of issue of the clearance letter, at least in two local newspapers that are widely circulated in the region of which one shall be in the vernacular language of the locality concerned and a copy of the same shall be forwarded to the concerned Regional Office of the Ministry.

(x) The project authorities shall inform the Regional Office as well as the Ministry, the date of financial closure and final approval of the project by the concerned authorities and the date of start of the project.

(xi) This Environmental clearance is granted subject to final outcome of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Hon'ble High Court, Hon'ble NGT and any other Court of Law, if any, as may be applicable to this project.

19. The Ministry reserves the right to stipulate additional conditions, if found necessary at subsequent stages and the project proponent shall implement all the said conditions in a time bound manner. The Ministry may revoke or suspend the environmental clearance, if implementation of any of the above conditions is not found satisfactory.

20. Concealing factual data or submission of false/fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned above may result in withdrawal of this clearance and attract action under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

21. Any appeal against this environmental clearance shall lie with the National Green Tribunal, if preferred, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 16 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.

22. The above conditions will be enforced, inter-alia under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991 read with subsequent amendments therein.

23. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.

6. The industry shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages, discharge of any pollutants gas/liquids from the vessels, mechanical equipment etc. which are likely to cause environment pollution.

7. The industry shall comply noise pollution (Regulation and control) Rules, 2000.

8. The industry shall comply all the direction/Rules/Instructions as may be issued by the MOEF/CPCB/HSPCB from time to time.

9. The industry shall ensure that various characteristics of the effluents remain within the tolerance limits as specified in EPA Standard and as amended from time to time and at no time the concentration of any characteristics should exceed these limits for discharge.

10. The industry would immediately submit the revised application to the Board in the event of any change in the raw material in process, mode of treatment/discharge of effluent. In case of change of process at any stage during the consent period, the industry shall submit fresh consent application alongwith the consent to operate fee, if found due, which may be on any account and that shall be paid by the industry and the industry would immediately submit the consent application to the Board in the event of any change during the year in the raw material, quantity, quality of the effluent, mode of discharge, treatment facilities etc.

“This LOI is being issued in bona-fide understanding pursuant to Hon’ble NGT Orders dated 28 September, 2018 and 30 October, 2018 and subject to the directions mentioned therein. You will be complying with the safety norms as specified by PESO and all others rules/ regulations framed by PESO in this regard and/or any directions issued by Hon’ble NGT/ any other court.”

Refer clause in the Tender/EOI No 1000393915, system ID 6683, The project proponents/ suppliers who have valid Long Term Offtake Agreement and offer quantity during the ESY 2022-23 will be given preferential allocation for supplying Ethanol to the extent of prorated design capacity for the balance period of ESY 22-23. However, the said suppliers are required to register themselves with OMCs for their upcoming plants (including expansion of existing distillery) and participate in the Ethanol Procurement process of OMCs during the ESY 22-23. In order to meet the above prorated annual off-take quantity as per agreement, if found necessary, the pre-allocated quantities awarded to bidders (other than DEPs) under this EOI may be reduced. Such reduction in allocated quantity will be carried out in the reverse order of EOI allocation criteria, as described below:

1. The allocation made to the farthest existing supplier from the OMC location from outside the state shall be reduced first.

4. Construction of observation well(s) (piezometer)(s) within the premises and installation of appropriate water level monitoring mechanism shall be mandatory for industries drawing or proposing to draw more than 500 kld of ground water and Monitoring of water level shall be done by project proponent. The piezometer (observation well) shall be constructed at a minimum distance of 25 m from the production well. Depth and aquifer zone tapped in the piezometer shall be the same as that of the pumping well wells Detailed guidelines for design and construction of piezometer is given on the portal. Monthly water level data shall be submitted to the HWRA through the web portal on quarterly basis.
5. The applicant with red category industries as per Haryana State Pollution Control Board shall store the harvested rainwater in surface storage tanks for use in the industry and shall not use the harvested rainwater to recharge ground water, further the applicants under this category shall ensure wellhead protection measures to prevent ground water pollution and will inform the compliance within 3 months.
6. Injection of treated/untreated wastewater/effluents into aquifer system is strictly prohibited.
7. The applicant drawing ground water in safe, semi-critical and critical assessment units shall be required to pay ground water abstraction charges on quarterly basis, applicable as per Tables 5.3A.
8. The applicant drawing ground water in over-exploited assessment units shall be liable to pay ground water restoration charges on quarterly basis, applicable as per Tables 5.3 B.
9. All the tube wells/ground water abstraction structures permitted shall be fixed with digital electromagnetic/ultrasonic water meters, by the industry at its own cost with telemetry system and monthly ground water abstraction data shall be recorded in a logbook. Daily water meter readings to be recorded in a dedicated register and shall be submitted on the web portal to HWRA on quarterly basis or through centralized mechanism evolved by HWRA. Without geotagged photos not showing date and coordinates will not be entertained.
10. The applicant, as per approved proposal, shall implement rainwater harvesting and ground water recharge measures within three months from the date of issuance of this NOC and undertake periodic maintenance of recharge structures. Photographs (with geo tag only) of the recharge structures etc. and compliance of completion of construction of the same along with copy of NOC shall be furnished immediately to the Haryana Water Resources Authority for verification, on the Email ID of the Authority (compliance - hwra@hry.gov.in)
11. The ground water chemical quality shall be monitored twice in a year during pre & post- monsoon period.



Impact of the pollution abatement measures taken on conservation of natural resources and on the cost of production.

By installation of Evaporators the company has already achieved zero liquid discharge in the distillery from starting of industry. Through Evaporators the whole effluent generated in distillery is converted into two parts .i.e. one part is condensate water & other part is concentrate.

The concentrate received from Evaporator is feed to dryer. After drying in dryer it is converted into DDGS/ Cattle feed and then sale out to the Cattle feed manufacturers.

The condensate water received from Evaporators is further treated ETP and recycle plant and the entire quantity of Treated water is sent to the process and cooling towers through treated water tank for reuse / recycles. ZLD of effluent is achieved.

Through the above reuse / recycling of the effluent, requirement for fresh water has been substantially reduced.

Grains used for Ethanol production, the effluent generation had already reduced to minimum requirement as possible.

The company has already invested capital cost earmarked towards environmental pollution control measures is Rs. 24.0 Crores and the Recurring cost (operation and maintenance) will be about Rs. 1.5 Crores / annum. on pollution control measures & conserving water besides environmental protection up 2023-24.


