

This has reference to your online proposal No. IA/HR/IND2/227212/2021, dated $01^{\rm st}$ September, 2021 for environmental clearance to the above mentioned project.

- **2.** The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has examined the proposal for proposed 215 KLPD Grain based Ethanol plant along with 6.0 MW Co-generation Power Plant at Village Firozpur, Tehsil Raipur Rani, District Panchkula, Haryana by M/s MG Petrochem Private Limited.
- **3.** All grain based fuel ethanol plants are listed at S.N. 5(ga) of Schedule of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 amendment vide S.O 2339 dated 16th June 2021 under category 'B-2' and appraised at Central Level by Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC). It was informed that no litigation is pending against the proposal.

4. The details of products and capacity are as under: -

- **5.** Total land required for the project is 7.76 hectares (77600 m^2). Industry will develop greenbelt in an area of 33% i.e. 2.56 ha (25600 m^2) out of total area of the project.
- **6.** The estimated project cost is Rs. 205 Crores. Total capital cost earmarked towards environmental pollution control measures is Rs. 24.0 Crores and the Recurring cost (operation and maintenance) will be about Rs. 1.5 Crores / annum. Total Employment will be 120 persons (Permanent 72 & temporary 48) during operation phase. Industry proposes to allocate Rs. 1.0 Crores of total project cost towards Social developmental activities.
- 7. There are No National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries, Biosphere Reserves, Tiger/ Elephant Reserves, Wildlife Corridors, lies within 10 km radius of the project site. PF like Rajpura PF (~4.5 km in NE direction), Gumti Sambhalwa RF (~7.5 km in East direction) & Kadana PF (~8.5 km in NNE direction), River/Nala i.e. Balrali Nadi (~1.0 km in SSE direction), Thathar ki Nadi (~3.5 km in North direction), Baliali Nala (~4.5 km in South direction), Dangri Nadi (~4.5 km in NW direction), Sangrel Nadi (~5.5 km in NE direction), Begna Nadi (~5.5 km in ESE direction), Ujjal ki Nadi (~7.5 km in SE direction) and Dudhgarh ki Nadi (~8.5 km in NW direction); Baliali Nala

- (4.5 km in South direction), Dhandiyon ka Nala (\sim 7.0 km in ENE direction) and Naura Nala (\sim 7.0 km in ENE direction) are found within 10 km radius.
- **8.** Total water requirement for the Grain based Ethanol Plant will be 3439 KLPD out of which 2372 KLPD will be recycled in plant operations. Hence, the fresh water requirement for the project will be 1097 KLPD (Ethanol Plant& Co-generation Power Plant and Utilities 1067 m3/day + Domestic: 30 m3/day) which will be sourced from groundwater. Effluent of 1212 m3/day will be treated through state of art CPU/Effluent Treatment Plant (Reverse Osmosis technology) of 1500 KLPD capacity. The plant will be based on Zero Liquid discharge system.
- **9.** Power requirement for Ethanol plant will be 4.0 MW, which will be sourced from the 6.0 MW Co-generation Power Plant. Construction power / standby power connection shall be taken from Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited. Unit will be having D.G. Sets of 2 x 1500 KVA which will be used as standby during power failure. Adequate Stack height (8 m) will be provided as per CPCB norms. Boiler of 50 TPH capacity with ESP as Air Pollution Control Equipment will be installed. ESP with a stack height of 60 m for 50 TPH boiler will be installed for controlling the particulate emissions within the statutory limit of 50 mg/Nm3.

10. Details of Process emissions generation and its management:

CO2 (164 TPD) generated during the fermentation process will be recovered by CO2 Scrubbers and sold to authorized vendors.

11. Details of Solid waste/Hazardous waste generation and its management:

- Solid waste from the Grain based operations generally comprises of fibres and proteins in the form of DDGS (94 TPD), which will be ideally used as Cattle, poultry & fish feed ingredients.
- Used oil & grease (0.5 KL/Annum) generated from plant machinery/gear boxes as hazardous waste will be sold out to the CPCB authorized recyclers.
- **12.** As per OM dated 16th June, 2021, PP has submitted self-certification in the form of affidavit declaring that the proposed capacity of 215 KLPD will be for manufacturing of fuel ethanol only.
- 13. During the appraisal EAC noted that proposed parking area of 10 % shall be increased to 15% of the total project area and PP obliged to it.
- **14.** The proposal was considered by the EAC in its 40th meeting held during 14th- 16th September, 2021 in the Ministry, wherein the project proponent and their consultant M/s J.M. EnviroNet Pvt. Ltd presented the EMP report as per the PFR. The Committee found the EMP report complying with the PFR and recommended the project for grant of environmental clearance.

- **15.** The EAC, constituted under the provision of the EIA Notification, 2006 and comprising of Experts Members/domain experts in various fields, have examined the proposal submitted by the Project Proponent in desired form along with EIA/EMP report prepared and submitted by the Consultant accredited by the QCI/ NABET on behalf of the Project Proponent. The EAC noted that the Project Proponent has given undertaking that the data and information given in the application and enclosures are true to the best of his knowledge and belief and no information has been suppressed in the EIA/EMP report. If any part of data/information submitted is found to be false/ misleading at any stage, the project will be rejected and Environmental Clearance given, if any, will be revoked at the risk and cost of the project proponent.
- **16.** The Committee has also deliberated on the CER plan and found to be addressing the issues in the study area. The EAC has deliberated the proposal and has made due diligence in the process as notified under the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006, as amended from time to time and accordingly made the recommendations to the proposal. The Experts Members of the EAC have found the proposal in order and have **recommended** for grant of environmental clearance.
- 17. The environmental clearance granted to the project/activity is strictly under the provisions of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments. It does not tantamount/construe to approvals/consent/ permissions etc. required to be obtained or standards/conditions to be followed under any other Acts/ Rules/ Subordinate legislations, etc., as may be applicable to the project. The project proponent shall obtain necessary permission as mandated under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as applicable from time to time, from the State Pollution Control Board, prior to construction & operation of the project.
- **18.** Based on the proposal submitted by the project proponent and recommendations of the EAC (Industry-2), Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change hereby **accords** environmental clearance for establishment of proposed 215 KLPD Grain based Ethanol plant along with 6.0 MW Co-generation Power Plant at Village Firozpur, Tehsil Raipur Rani, District Panchkula, Haryana by M/s MG Petrochem Private Limited, under the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006, and the amendments therein, subject to compliance of the terms and conditions as under: -

A. Specific Conditions:

(i) As per OM dated 16th June, 2021, project falls in category B2 and the proposed additional capacity of 215 KLPD shall be only for fuel ethanol manufacturing as per self-certification in form of an affidavit by the Project Proponent. Provided that subsequently if it is found that the ethanol, produced based on the EC granted as per this dispensation, is not being used completely for EBP Programme, or if ethanol is not being produced, or

if the said distillery is not fulfilling the requirements based on which the project has been appraised as category B2 project, the EC shall stand cancelled.

- (ii) The company shall comply with all the environmental protection measures and safeguards proposed in the documents submitted to the Ministry. All the recommendations made in the EIA/EMP in respect of environmental management, and risk mitigation measures relating to the project shall be implemented.
- (iii) The project proponent will treat and reuse the treated water within the factory and no waste or treated water shall be discharged outside the premises.
- (iv) Total fresh water requirement shall be 1097 KLPD which will be met ground water. Extraction of ground water shall not be done without obtaining prior permission of CGWA/concerned authority. No ground water recharge shall be permitted within the premises.
- (v) The spent wash shall be concentrated and dried to form DDGS to be used as cattle feed.
- (vi) CO₂ generated from the process shall be bottled/made solid ice and utilized/sold to authorized vendors.
- (vii) Occupational Health Centre for surveillance of the worker's health shall be set up. The health data shall be used in deploying the duties of the workers. All workers & employees shall be provided with required safety kits/mask for personal protection.
- (viii) Training shall be imparted to all employees on safety and health aspects of chemicals handling. Safety and visual reality training shall be provided to employees.
- (ix) The unit shall make the arrangement for protection of possible fire hazards during manufacturing process in material handling. Firefighting system shall be as per the norms.
- (x) Process organic residue and spent carbon, if any, shall be sent to Cement other suitable industries for its incinerations. ETP sludge, process inorganic & evaporation salt shall be disposed of to the TSDF.
- (xi) The company shall undertake waste minimization measures as below (a) Metering and control of quantities of active ingredients to minimize waste; (b) Reuse of by-products from the process as raw materials or as raw material substitutes in other processes. (c) Use of automated filling to minimize spillage. (d) Use of Close Feed system into batch reactors. (e) Venting equipment through vapour recovery system. (f) Use of high pressure hoses for equipment clearing to reduce wastewater generation.

- (xii) The green belt of 5 m width shall be developed in nearly 33% of the total project area, mainly along the plant periphery. Selection of plant species shall be as per the CPCB guidelines in consultation with the State Forest Department. Records of tree canopy shall be monitored through remote sensing map.
- (xiii) As committed PP shall allocate Rs. 1.0 Crore for CER and shall be used for implementing energy conservation measures and skill development for women/girls in nearby villages.
- (xiv) There shall be 15% space inside the plant premises earmarked for parking of vehicles for raw materials and finished products as per CPCB norms and no parking to be allowed outside on public places.
- (xv) Storage of raw materials shall be either stored in silos or in covered areas to prevent dust pollution and other fugitive emissions.
- (xvi) Continuous online (24x7) monitoring system for stack emissions shall be installed for measurement of flue gas discharge and the pollutants concentration, and the data to be transmitted to the CPCB and SPCB server. For online continuous monitoring of effluent, the unit shall install web camera with night vision capability and flow meters in the channel/drain carrying effluent within the premises.
- (xvii) A separate Environmental Management Cell (having qualified person with Environmental Science/Environmental Engineering/specialization in the project area) equipped with full-fledged laboratory facilities shall be set up to carry out the Environmental Management and Monitoring functions.

B. General Conditions:

- (i) No further expansion or modifications in the plant, other than mentioned in the EIA Notification, 2006 and its amendments, shall be carried out without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change/SEIAA, as applicable. In case of deviations or alterations in the project proposal from those submitted to this Ministry for clearance, a fresh reference shall be made to the Ministry/SEIAA, as applicable, to assess the adequacy of conditions imposed and to add additional environmental protection measures required, if any.
- (ii) The energy source for lighting purpose shall be preferably LED based, or advanced having preference in energy conservation and environment betterment.
- (iii) The overall noise levels in and around the plant area shall be kept well within the standards by providing noise control measures including acoustic hoods, silencers, enclosures etc. on all sources of noise generation. The ambient noise levels shall conform to the standards prescribed under the

Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 Rules, 1989 viz. 75 dBA (day time) and 70 dBA (night time).

- (iv) The company shall undertake all relevant measures for improving the socio-economic conditions of the surrounding area. CER activities shall be undertaken by involving local villages and administration and shall be implemented. The company shall undertake eco-developmental measures including community welfare measures in the project area for the overall improvement of the environment.
- (v) The company shall earmark sufficient funds towards capital cost and recurring cost per annum to implement the conditions stipulated by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change as well as the State Government along with the implementation schedule for all the conditions stipulated herein. The funds so earmarked for environment management/pollution control measures shall not be diverted for any other purpose.
- (vi) A copy of the clearance letter shall be sent by the project proponent to concerned Panchayat, Zilla Parishad/Municipal Corporation, Urban local Body and the local NGO, if any, from whom suggestions/ representations, if any, were received while processing the proposal.
- (vii) The project proponent shall also submit six monthly reports on the status of compliance of the stipulated Environmental Clearance conditions including results of monitored data (both in hard copies as well as by e-mail) to the respective Regional Office of MoEF&CC, the respective Zonal Office of CPCB and SPCB. A copy of Environmental Clearance and six monthly compliance status report shall be posted on the website of the company.
- (viii) The environmental statement for each financial year ending 31st March in Form-V as is mandated shall be submitted to the concerned State Pollution Control Board as prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, as amended subsequently, shall also be put on the website of the company along with the status of compliance of environmental clearance conditions and shall also be sent to the respective Regional Offices of MoEF&CC by e-mail.
- (ix) The project proponent shall inform the public that the project has been accorded environmental clearance by the Ministry and copies of the clearance letter are available with the SPCB/Committee and may also be seen at Website of the Ministry and at https://parivesh.nic.in/. This shall be advertised within seven days from the date of issue of the clearance letter, at least in two local newspapers that are widely circulated in the region of which one shall be in the vernacular language of the locality concerned and a copy of the same shall be forwarded to the concerned Regional Office of the Ministry.
- (x) The project authorities shall inform the Regional Office as well as the Ministry, the date of financial closure and final approval of the project by the concerned authorities and the date of start of the project.

- (xi) This Environmental clearance is granted subject to final outcome of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Hon'ble High Court, Hon'ble NGT and any other Court of Law, if any, as may be applicable to this project.
- **19.** The Ministry reserves the right to stipulate additional conditions, if found necessary at subsequent stages and the project proponent shall implement all the said conditions in a time bound manner. The Ministry may revoke or suspend the environmental clearance, if implementation of any of the above conditions is not found satisfactory.
- **20.** Concealing factual data or submission of false/fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned above may result in withdrawal of this clearance and attract action under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- **21.** Any appeal against this environmental clearance shall lie with the National Green Tribunal, if preferred, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 16 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.
- **22.** The above conditions will be enforced, inter-alia under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991 read with subsequent amendments therein.
- **23.** This issues with the approval of the competent authority.





The delivery should commence within 15 days from the date of LOI or 7 days from the date of the PO, once placed, whichever is earlier.

Security Deposit (SD):

Security deposit of 03% of basic contract value in the form of BG/ retention of SD amount from initial invoices, for the full allocation of ESY 2022-23 will be given by the successful vendor within one month of issuance of LOI. It is to be clearly understood that, particularly in respect of States where the State Excise Dept. has relinquished its control & monitoring for Denatured Ethanol as per amendment to IDR Act, the entire responsibility of proper Denaturation of Ethanol and en-route malpractice, if any; will be that of the Supplier and OMCs will not be responsible for the same in any manner and directions of respective state govt. who have relinquished control, the conditions stipulated if any be followed by Suppliers.

Change of Distillery:

The supplier who has multiple distilleries registered with BPC under the EOI, due to some issue in the original distillery, supplier shall be allowed to change to alternate distillery (ies) during the period of contract with following conditions: -

- 1. The alternate distillery (ies) can be located in the same state or other state. Quantities so accepted from the alternate distillery, will be allocated by OMCs to the needy locations.
- 2. Certificate from state excise clearly mentioning the reason for non-supply of Ethanol from the original distillery.
- 3. Certificate from state excise clearly mentioning the alternate distillery of the supplier from which the pending quantity is proposed to be supplied. This pending quantity supplied by alternate distillery will be adjusted from allocation of original distillery.
- 4. The transportation rate applicable shall be less than or equal to the rate as per original contract.
- 5. Change of distillery is allowed for:

 - Distilleries belonging to the holding company or wholly owned subsidiary of the supplier company.
 - Certificate from practicing chartered accountant/ company secretary needs to be submitted
 to establish that new supplier is either a holding company or wholly owned subsidiary of the

Corrective Measures For Improving Blending Percentage

Price reduction clause:


PRC amount shall be deducted from the payment due to the vendors and/ or by encashing security deposit. OMCs decision in the above cases shall be final.

In addition to above PRC amount, any statutory tax shall be payable as applicable.

In case state government have not issued guidelines for supply of Ethanol produced from Sugarcane Juice/Sugar/Sugar Syrup and/or B Heavy Molasses then in such cases the PRC shall not be applicable for the period until such time certification is started by Excise or any other competent authority in State. Validity of this NOC shall be subject to compliance of the following mandatory conditions

This NOC for abstraction of ground water, shall be subject to the following terms and conditions

- NOC is granted to the applicant on the condition that local government water supply agencies are not able to supply the desired quantity of
 water. In case of supply of water from local agency the applicant shall immediately inform HWRA and reduce the abstraction of ground
 water accordingly.
- 2. The applicant shall adopt latest water efficient technologies to reduce dependence on ground water resources by 20% in three years. Compliance report in this regard shall be submitted yearly. The proof of reduction of dependence on ground water shall also be submitted half yearly i.e., at the time of deposit of water abstraction charges of the second quarter.
- The applicant abstracting ground water between 100-500 kld shall undertake self-annual water audit and those abstracting ground water
 more than 500 kld shall undertake water audit through organisations authorised by Government of India or HWRA and submit audit
 reports at the time of renewal of the NOC.
- 4. Construction of observation well(s) (piezometer)(s) within the premises and installation of appropriate water level monitoring mechanism shall be mandatory for industries drawing or proposing to draw more than 500 kld of ground water and Monitoring of water level shall be done by project proponent. The piezometer (observation well) shall be constructed at a minimum distance of 25 m from the production well. Depth and aquifer zone tapped in the piezometer shall be the same as that of the pumping well wells Detailed guidelines for design and construction of piezometer is given on the portal. Monthly water level data shall be submitted to the HRWA through the web portal on quarterly basis.
- 5. The applicant with red category industries as per Haryana State Pollution Control Board shall store the harvested rainwater in surface storage tanks for use in the industry and shall not use the harvested rainwater to recharge ground water, further the applicants under this category shall ensure wellhead protection measures to prevent ground water pollution and will inform the compliance within 3 months.
- 6. Injection of treated/untreated wastewater/effluents into aquifer system is strictly prohibited.
- 7. The applicant drawing ground water in safe, semi-critical and critical assessment units shall be required to pay ground water abstraction charges on quarterly basis, applicable as per Tables 5.3A.
- 8. The applicant drawing ground water in over-exploited assessment units shall be liable to pay ground water restoration charges on quarterly basis, applicable as per Tables 5.3 B.
- 9. All the tube wells/ground water abstraction structures permitted shall be fixed with digital electromagnetic/ultrasonic water meters, by the industry at its own cost with telemetry system and monthly ground water abstraction data shall be recorded in a logbook. Compliance to this condition shall be reported within one month from the date of issue of this letter. Daily water meter readings to be recorded in a dedicated register and shall be submitted on the web portal to HWRA on quarterly basis or through centralized mechanism evolved by HWRA. The geotag photos of all the flow meters/water meters showing date and coordinates be uploaded on the portal for calculation of quarterly tariff. Without geotagged photos not showing date and coordinates will not be entertained.
- 10. The applicant, as per approved proposal, shall implement rainwater harvesting and ground water recharge measures within three months from the date of issuance of this NOC and undertake periodic maintenance of recharge structures. Photographs (with geo tag only) of the recharge structures etc. and compliance of completion of construction of the same along with copy of NOC shall be furnished immediately to the Haryana Water Resources Authority for verification, on the Email ID of the Authority (compliance hwra@hry.gov.in)
- 11. The ground water chemical quality shall be monitored twice in a year during pre & post- monsoon period.
- 12. The monthly ground water level monitoring data in respect of piezometer shall be submitted quarterly to the Haryana Water Resources Authority on regular basis.
- 13. The applicant shall ensure proper recycling and reuse, including use for green belt, of wastewater after adequate treatment.
- 14. In case of renewal, application shall be submitted online within 90 days before the expiry of this NOC and abstraction of ground water, after expiry of NOC shall be illegal and liable for legal action as per law.
- 15. The applicant shall seek prior permissions from HWRA for any increase in daily quantum of groundwater abstraction (i.e. more than the permitted limit in the NOC).
- 16. Where the applicant granted NOC for abstraction of saline water and the existing well(s) is/are yielding fresh water, the same shall be sealed and new tube well(s) tapping saline water shall be constructed within 3 months of the issuance of NOC or from the date of seal of the fresh water tube well, as the case may be. The applicant shall be also ensuring safe disposal of saline residue, if any.
- 17. The applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Haryana Water Resources (Conservation, Regulation and Management) Authority Act, 2020, Rules, regulations, guidelines and directions issued thereunder. Non-compliance of these provisions shall be liable for the penalty as per the provisions of the Act, rules and regulations, guidelines and directions issued thereunder.
- 18. The applicant shall ensure the 100% reuse for non potable usage of self generated waste water after due treatment. He shall also ensure to reuse for non potable usage the Treated Waste Water (other than self generated) as per application and NOC terms & conditions.
- 19. Since, this NOC has been issued on the basis of self-assessment by the applicant and without any site inspection, hence the Authority may inspect the site/unit and documents at any time. In case any material difference is found in the information submitted and the site conditions or documents, the Authority may suspend the NOC granted immediately and may revoke or modify the NOC after giving a notice to the applicant.
- 20. This NOC is subject to prevailing State Government rules/law of Courts orders related to construction of tube well, ground water withdrawal, construction of recharge or conservation structure/discharge of effluents or any such matters as applicable.
- 21. The applicant shall comply with the directions/conditions/instructions issued by any Court of law related to the matters concerned with the Authority.
- 22. The applicant shall report self-compliance duly signed by authorized person along with authorization letter by e-mail to Haryana Water Resources Authority quarterly as well as yearly basis after the issuance of NOC.
- 23. This NOC does not absolve the applicant of his obligation/requirement to obtain the necessary approvals from the statutory and administrative Authorities/Departments.
- 24. The issuance of this NOC does not imply that other statutory or administrative clearances shall necessarily be granted to the applicant by the concerned authorities. The concerned Authorities shall act as per their own procedure.
- 25. The applicant shall immediately inform the HWRA, if any change in the information provided by the applicant in the application form for seeking NOC.
- 26. This NOC shall not absolve the applicant from any penalty/punishment/environment compensation, which may have been imposed or may be imposed, for abstraction of groundwater during such period, before the issuance of this NOC.
- 27. In case of non-payment or delayed payment of ground water abstraction/restoration charges, a penal interest @ 18% shall be charged.
- 28. The necessary compliance shall be submitted to the Authority on the web portal of the Authority i.e. www.hwra.org.in or on the email id compliance-hwra@hry.gov.in.
- 29. In case validity period of the CTE/CTO expires during currency period of the NOC, then it will be responsibility of the project proponent to get it renewed well in time & submit renewed CTE/CTO within month after renewal of CTE/CTO by HSPCB, to HWRA. If the CTE/CTO has been suspended or rejected, project proponent is required to intimate the same to HWRA within a week of such rejection or suspension.

By installation of Evaporators the company has already achieved zero liquid discharge in the distillery from starting of industry. Through Evaporators the whole effluent generated in distillery is converted into two parts .i.e. one part is condensate water & other part is concentrate.

The concentrate received from Evaporator is feed to dryer. After drying in dryer it is converted into DDGS/ Cattle feed and then sale out to the Cattle feed manufacturers.

The condensate water received from Evaporators is further treated ETP and recycle plant and the entire quantity of Treated water is sent to the process and cooling towers through treated water tank for reuse / recycles. ZLD of effluent is achieved.

Through the above reuse / recycling of the effluent, requirement for fresh water has been substantially reduced.




